RULES OF ENTRY

There is a \$10 entry fee to enter a maximum of 3 images into the contest.

Artist must be a high school student in the United States.

Applicants may upload 1-3 images (jpg). For good quality and fast uploads, image files should be sized no larger than 1280 px @ 72dpi. The slideroom portal offers additional instructions for submitting work and helping new applicants get started. For technical assistance, go to <https://support.slideroom.com>

Each artist warrants that he/she has obtained all necessary releases from models and other subjects featured in photographs selected for exhibition.

Artists agree to let Drexel University Photography Program use submitted images for promotional materials. Accepted artists may be asked for a higher resolution file than originally submitted.

Submission of an entry to this competition implies acknowledgement that entrant data is available to the university and acceptance of all the concerns here stated.

EXHIBITION NOTES

Selected artwork must be received no later than January 10, 2020.

Artwork must be matted, outside dimensions of the mat must be 11x14.

Winning artists are responsible for packing photographs in a resealable package with adequate packaging for return (or include new return packaging inside) and must include return postage. Artwork that does not include return postage will not be returned.
