Film and Media Arts Guidelines

Deadline for submissions:

Thursday, March 1st, 2018 by 11:59 PM.

Submission Types

- Films submissions may be narrative, documentary, animation, stop motion, instructional, etc. Silent (music only) films are also welcome.
- Digital Photography submissions may be documentary, conceptual, portrait, environment, color, black and white, and mixed media.
- Non-digital photography should be submitted to the Visual Arts category of the Student Arts Contest.
- All other digitally-created artistic content is accepted. This content includes, but is not limited to, animations, websites, graphics, logos, and interactive media.

Technical Requirements: FILM

- Films should be 1920x1080 HD, H.264, MP4 or MOV files.
- Films should be uploaded to unlisted YouTube video or Vimeo password protected video.

Check the following tutorials if you need help:

- How to set my Youtube video as unlisted
- How to put password to a Vimeo video (Please use the password PST2017)

- Films should be a maximum of six (6) minutes in length, including credits.
- If submissions are not in English, please provide English subtitles.
- One submission per film. If the film was made by more than one student, only one student from the group should submit it.
- Films should be the equivalent of a G-rated motion picture, be appropriate for all audiences, and show cultural sensitivity.
- Film should have no technical issues with images or sound.

Technical Requirements: DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY

- When submitting a photograph, please only upload one file. Do not upload multiple versions of the same photograph.
- Series of no more than 5 photographs are accepted. Upload one file for each of the photographs in the series.
- Each image file size should have a minimum of 1MB and maximum of 5 MB.

Technical Requirements: DIGITAL MEDIA

- Please submit work in the format that works best for your digital creation.
 - .JPG or .PNG uploads will best represent works like logos or graphics.
 - Providing URL(s) will best represent original websites and web content.
 - Please reach out to <u>artsmatter@lapromisefund.org</u> if you need assistance choosing the correct submission type.

Additional Information

- All submissions must be original and should not infringe upon the copyright or other intellectual property or other legal or moral rights of any other person or entity.
- Students must obtain educational or contest-use authorization for music used. Or students may use royalty-free music created by other students, parents or others.
- Submissions may be used for promotional purposes by LA Promise Fund, Pacific Standard Time: LA/LA and/or the Getty. By entering the Student Arts Contest, the submitter agrees that all parties represented in the submission provide consent to be featured in such promotion.
