

**Photo Project Summer Semester: The Head-shot / Portrait – 24 photos or more total in a Folder.**

## **Headshots and Portraits of one person only!**

**The following is just a general guideline or suggestion. You are not required to follow this exactly.**

**Photograph one person's face close up from just below the shoulders to the top of their head. Do 6 or more photos this way.**

**Then shoot 6 or more photos from the waist up to the top of their head.**

**3/4 View, crop from their knees up – Try 6 or more this way.**

**Full length, Showing them in full view from feet to head, This could be done with them sitting or standing. Try 6 or more this way.**

**Try to make them look either attractive, or interesting & unusual!**

**Consider your lighting & their facial expressions. Try using the lens zoomed in close for a more flattering effect, instead of the normal lens. Try to keep shadows off the face, by using a reflector, or using flash with daylight, or posing them in the shade. Keep the background simple and uncluttered.**

**Above all review your lighting and focus after the first few shots and make adjustments. Once you have good lighting, the perfect exposure, good focus and an uncluttered background – STAY THERE AND SHOOT 8-24 photos! The rest is just directing your subject.**

**If you get 12 or more truly great shots then you could be making good money doing this!**

**(I can also coach you in how to get started getting this type of work.)**
