Principal, staff, teachers and parents:

Per our conversation with the school recently, I am sending you some more details to familiarize you with what we have done the last eight years. We held two San Pedro competitions in 201 3 and 201 4 and a harbor-wide competition in 201 5 thru 2019.

The videos are about the receptions so it features the kids, friends and family as well as the artwork.

The competition is available to all students from TK to high school.

The media accepted is 2D (drawings, paintings, photography) and should be in the following standardized sizes (unmatted and unframed) up to  $11 \times 15$  for drawings, paintings and mixed media,  $8 \times 10$  and  $11 \times 14$  for photography and  $11 \times 14$  and  $16 \times 20$  for canvas and canvas board.

A panel of art professionals will juror the show.

No restriction on subject matter. The appropriateness of the subject matter will be up to the discretion of the jurors.

Students whose artwork is accepted will be eligible for cash prizes for 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and Honorable Mention at all three grade levels (Elementary. Middle and High School) and will receive art supplies, ribbons, student membership in SPAA and a three month exhibition of their framed art at Crafted at the Port of Los Angeles.

The deadline for turn in of artwork at the school will be April 23th. Artwork will be picked up in the main office on April 24th.

An email with all the rules and submission requirements as well as parental permission forms and entry labels will start being sent this February 2020.

We don't want to crowd a teacher's curriculum, so we encourage the kids to do this project on their own time whether at school or at home.

This is a great opportunity to recognize, reward and encourage the kids' artistic talents.

We hope you all encourage the students' participation in this year's competition.
