2. Deadline: Friday, February 7th
3. We take any and everything artistic...drawings, doodles, short stories, poems, expository writing, essays, news articles, haikus, photos, sculptures (photos of), graffiti, animation frames, comics, music, fashion...whatever! We try to fit in ALL forms of talented artwork!
4. Digital drawings and photographs should be printed and placed in this envelope, or emailed to us at pvphsliterarymagazine@gmail.com if absolutely necessary. We will ask for a digital copy if your piece is selected.
5. Students can get their art entries back during the month of May – in room H65. Please stop by to pick it up as items will not be returned after the end of the year. Poetry and prose entries will not be returned.
6. Write your **NAME, EMAIL, and TITLE OF YOUR WORK** on the back of your submission.
7. We **CANNOT** publish anonymous entries or untitled pieces!
8. The review process is anonymous! The staff will not know which pieces you created unless they are selected for the magazine.
9. Publication will come out in last week of May and costs ten dollars.
10. Students will be notified in April if their submission has been selected for inclusion in the magazine.
