Demonstrations and discussions include darkroom techniques such as color correcting, print exposure, print manipulation, and the use of instant and alternative color materials. One - on – one critiques encourage students to establish a foundation for the expression of a personal vision.

This class will explore the many different aspects of Fashion Photography; from the business side of self promotion, making good contacts and putting together a good creative team, to a hands on look at producing and shooting a fashion layout, working with model agencies, make-up and hair stylists, and fashion stylists. Two thirds of the classes will be spent shooting live models, with make-up and hair stylists, demonstrations on lighting for beauty, lighting for the body, and lighting on location and with daylight. Instruction on how to build a fashion portfolio through "Testing" with beginning models and make-up artists. Also a look at posing and un-posing models, and what to avoid. Guest speakers from the industry will also be invited to work with the class. There will also be a brief overview of the history of fashion photography and it's ever changing styles.
