150 words of writing are also required to go along with these images! They can be added text to the video, spoken in the video, or turned in as a word document.

In the images and writings I would like you to illustrate your feelings or experiences during this quarantine. Show us the bad and/or the good aspects of it.

It is open to a wide range of subject matter, your family, yourself, pets, what you do for fun to pass the time, or what frustrations you may have. You could show images of empty grocery store shelves, news headlines, screen captures of computer errors, the many different Apps we now need to use on screen, or images of isolation and empty streets.

You could also show the positive aspects like a greater closeness to family, the home and pets. Maybe you started cooking more or had a family BBQ. Images of screens showing your favorite Social Media, Friends, Places to relax, TV shows or Zoom sessions are other options. Consider also masks, rubber gloves or even some self-portraits!
