Objective: Explore the use of pattern and line; be able to tell the difference between the two art elements.

**Line** (straight, curvy, thin, or thick).

Line is one of the seven [elements of art](#). It is considered by many to be the most basic element of art. In terms of art, line is considered "a moving dot".

A simple way of thinking of a line is to imagine a point that moves...

**Pattern** (objects, shapes or lines that repeat)

**PATTERN** is a design that repeats and can be found anywhere. They can be made by repeating shape, line, or color. Patterns can be simple like a checkerboard.
